*LIT 104 – Completing any of the following 200-level literature courses (LIT 201, LIT 202, LIT 204, or LIT 270) may also satisfy this requirement. Any course taken for the fulfillment of this general education requirement may not count for the diversity requirement of the General Education curriculum or for a course within any major.

**SCI 101 – Completing any of the following courses (BIOL 103, BIOL 104, BIOL 105, CHEM 105, PHYS 101, PHYS 102, SCI 201) or any natural science, computer science, or engineering course that has an associated lab, if the lab is also completed, will also satisfy this requirement.

***Additional MATH, STAT, or Science Course – One additional three- or four-credit course in math, statistics, computer science, engineering, or any of the natural sciences will satisfy this requirement.

****Additional Social Science Course – One additional three-credit course in any of the social disciplines (i.e., Economics, Political Science, Psychology, or Sociology) will fulfill this requirement.

*****Gen Ed Diversity Requirement: Taking any World Language or ASL course at the 200 level or above satisfies this requirement.

†Writing Electives – English majors must take ONE of the following:

††Genre Electives – English majors must take ONE of the following:
