Sequence of courses may be altered with advisor's approval; a total of 128 credits are needed for graduation.

NOTE 1: Students MUST complete a minor or second major in a pre-professional area, such as criminal justice, business, education, nursing, occupational therapy, pre-law, pre-medicine, physical therapy, or social work. Double majors in Psychology and OT should declare this track. If the minor requires more than 3-credits per class, a student does not need as many free electives. Once the minor requirement is met, a student can fill in with free elective(s). The total credits needed by graduation must equal 128.

NOTE 2: This requirement can also be satisfied with LIT 201, 202, 204, 207, or 270

NOTE 3: The Writing Competency Exam (WCE) must be completed and passed in the junior year; if it is not the student will be automatically enrolled in CORE 199, a 1-credit writing course that will help improve writing skills.

NOTE 4: PSYC 410 (elective) and 322 = even-numbered year spring semester. PSYC 323 = odd-numbered year spring semester. PSYC 302 = every odd-numbered year fall semester. Please plan your schedule accordingly.

NOTE 5: If your 2nd major or concentration requires an internship, it may count towards this psychology requirement with a course substitution waiver form; psychology/O.T. double majors will **automatically** complete their psychology internship when they register for O.T. 403 during their Master's degree phase (i.e., no course waiver form is needed for them).

NOTE 6: Three additional psychology courses must be taken from this list: 205, 206, 321, 406, 405, 415-419, 398/399, 412-430, 499 or 501
