\*\*\*Psychology capstone must be completed for 3 credits but more credits are possible. PSYC 407 only serves as CORE III. PSYC 398/399 or PSYC 487 serve as CORE Applied Learning. Whichever psychology capstone is completed, the additional core requirement for upper-level students is required beyond it. All psychology capstone options serve as Exam 401. PSYC 311-312 must be taken prior to Applied Learning option.
