1.) *I wonder why he stayed up so late last night*

2.) *Do you know that Dr. Thomas still hasn't finished her report yet*

3.) *Shame on Dr. Thomas*

4.) *Turn in your report, please*

5.) *I asked her if she had chosen her major yet*

6.) *I asked Stephanie do you know if you'll study art history*

Answer Key

1.) *I wonder why he stayed up so late last night. (This is a declarative statement and requires a period.)*

2.) *Do you know that Dr. Thomas still hasn't finished her report yet? (This is an interrogative statement, requiring a question mark.)*

3.) *Shame on Dr. Thomas! (This is an exclamatory statement, expressing strong emotion. It requires an exclamation point.)*

4.) *Turn in your report, please. (This is an imperative statement, requiring a period.)*

5.) *I asked her if she had chosen her major yet. (This is a declarative statement and requires a period.)*

6.) *I asked Stephanie, "Do you know if you'll study art history?" (This sentence contains an interrogative, which, because it is spoken dialogue, is enclosed in quotation marks.)*
